Muslims

Australians think that 18% of their population are Muslim, when it's only 2%

Christians

Americans think 56% of their population are Christian, when the actual figure is 78%



Immigration

In Belgium the public think 29% of the population are immigrants. It's actually 10%

Ageing population

Italians think nearly half their population (48%) are 65+, when it's only 21%

Voters

Every country underestimates how many people vote.

The French are particularly pessimistic they think only 57% voted in the presidential election, when 80% did



Unemployment

People greatly overestimate unemployment levels.

 Even the Japanese, who do well on most questions, think 19% are unemployed when the actual figure is 4%
